I. TERMS OF APPOINTMENT:

The Recruitment Rules and Pay & Allowances of IIIT Sri City are benchmarked with CFTI (Centrally Funded Technical Institutions- under MHRD, Government of India) along with 7th CPC guidelines. Faculty will be appointed on regular basis with all possible service benefits. The term of employment may be ended by either side with a notice period of 3 months or end of the semester, whichever is later.

Important Information:

Higher starting pay will be offered to candidates possessing exceptional research and academic credentials.

In addition to benefits equivalent to 7Th CPC, faculty members are eligible for *additional allowances* as approved by the Board of Governors.

A proposal is under consideration of the Board of Governorsto offerannual *performance-based financial incentives* commensurate with above-normal contributions in teaching, research and administration.

Further Instructions:

- 1. Candidates working in Govt. Organizations either should get their application forwarded through proper channel or will require to submit a "No Objection Certificate" from their employers at the time of interview, if shortlisted.
- 2. Submission of application does not provide right to be called for interview. If a candidate is called for interview, he/she will not get any right for selection and appointment. There is no system or practice to send any written communication to candidates not called for interview or who are not selected after interview, indicating the reasons for rejections. Institute has the option to limit the number of candidates called for interview considering number of positions to be filled in, specialization requirement, subject discipline, etc.
- 3. Possession of essential qualification and experience does not guarantee candidate to be called for interview. Institute has authority to limit number of candidates to be called for interview based on qualification, experience, specialization requirement etc.
