Dear candidate,

We congratulate you for securing admission to BTech programme in IIIT Sri City through JoSAA/CSAB counseling. All candidates who have confirmed their seats through JoSAA-2023 and/or CSAB-2023 Special Rounds I & II as per the JoSAA/CSAB guidelines given in CSAB website are required to complete the following process for the academic year 2023-2024 through online reporting only at the allotted institute (IIIT Sri City) from 14<sup>th</sup> August, 2023 (10:00 Hrs) to 21<sup>st</sup> August, 2023 (17:00 Hrs) by paying balance fee and uploading the documents through google link at the allotted Institute (IIIT Sri City).

### A. Steps to be followed to towards the admission process:

- Fee payment related: Candidates who have paid the partial admission fee to JoSSA/CSAB and received the provisional admission letter from JoSAA/CSAB 2023 are required to pay the balance Fee Rs.155,000 (Gen, Gen-EWS, OBC-NCL) OR Rs.195,000 (SC, ST, PwD) to IIIT Sri City through SB Collect (details are given in the Annexure A)
- After the completion of remaining balance fee payment to IIIT Sri City, you need to
  upload the required documents (list of documents is provided in Appendix B) for
  verification using the following google link: https://forms.gle/V1JUveqG6wPLaznr7
- 3. The documents uploaded by the candidates will be verified in online mode only during 14 Aug 2023 (Mon) (10:00 hrs) to 21 Aug 2023 (Mon) (17:00 hrs), also the admission confirmation letter from IIIT Sri City will be sent on a first come first serve basis.
- 4. Submission of mandatory Anti-ragging affidavits (Online link will be shared to the candidates after completion of admission formalities).

- 14. Category Certificate (SC/ST/OBC-NCL/GEN-EWS), if applicable, as per Government of India format, available on the JoSAA-2023 website, issued by the competent authority. In case of OBC-NCL/GEN-EWS category, the certificate must be issued on or after April 01, 2023.

- i) Caste certificate (SC/ST/OBC-NCL) issued by Maharashtra State must be validated by Social Welfare department (in case of SC and OBC-NCL category) and Tribal Welfare department (in case of ST category) of Maharashtra Government. The SC/ST/OBC-NCL candidates of Maharashtra State have to produce their caste validity certificate in the format available on JoSAA/CSAB 2023 website.
- (ii)ST certificates from Tamil Nadu state must be issued by the concerned Revenue Divisional Officer
- 15. Original Certificate for Persons with Disabilities (PwD), if applicable, issued by the competent authority. Refer JoSAA/CSAB 2023 website for format
- 16. Medical Certificate (in specified Format available on JoSAA/CSAB 2023 format, Annexure 7)
- 17. Signed undertaking form (format will be sent separately by email)
