Mode of selection for all posts:

There are two parts of evaluation (A) Seminar and (B) Interview. All shortlisted candidates recommended by the screening committee have to appear for a Seminar presentation. The candidates recommended by the Seminar assessment committee will only be called for an interview. The final selection of candidates will be based only on the interview performance.

Terms of Appointment:

The Recruitment Rules and Pay & Allowances of IIIT Sri City are benchmarked with CFTI (Centrally Funded Technical Institutions under Ministry of Education, Government of India) along with 7th CPC guidelines. Faculty will be appointed on a regular basis with all possible service benefits. The other terms of employment and benefits are governed by the service conditions laid down by the Board of Governors of IIIT Sri City.

Important Information:

In addition to pay & allowances equivalent to 7th CPC, faculty members are eligible for *additional allowances* as approved by the Board of Governors such as seed grant, professional development allowance and annual *performance-based financial incentives* for performance above benchmark level in teaching, research and administration, etc. The institute also offers higher HRA, LTA, medical insurance, etc.

However, hard copy of application along with documents should reach the undersigned before 05/Jan/2024 (Please note that hard copy of the application along with documents is mandatory).

The candidates are required to attach the latest category certificate (SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS/PwD obtained from the competent authority. The OBC certificate as per GoI format obtained on or after 01-07-2023 is only valid.

Further Instructions:

- 1. Reservation is as per Government of India norms.
- 2. Refer to the application form for details on the information and documents required. Submit any supporting documents/certificates for each of the components in the application form.
- 3. Candidates working in Government Organizations either should get their application forwarded through a proper channel or will be required to submit a "No Objection Certificate" from their employers at the time of the interview if shortlisted.
- 4. Submission of an application does not provide the right to be called for an interview. If a candidate is called for an interview, he/she will not get any right for selection and appointment. There is no system or practice to send any written communication to candidates not called for an interview or who are not selected after the interview, indicating the reasons for rejections.
- 5. Possession of essential qualifications and experience does not guarantee a candidate to be called for an interview. Institute has the authority to limit the number of candidates to be called for an interview based on qualification, experience, specialization requirement, etc.
- 6. Incomplete applications, printed applications submitted without a signature on each page, applications that are not clearly legible, applications submitted without supporting documents, will not be placed before Scrutiny Committees and the same will be treated as rejected.
- 7. The recruitment process may be canceled by the Competent Authority at any time and no candidate will have any claim for issue of an appointment letter, as a matter of right, even after recommendations by the Selection (Interview) Committees.
