### Advertisement for recruitment of Teaching positions at IIIT Sri City

Indian Institute of Information Technology Sri City, Chittoor known as IIIT Sri City (IIITS) was established in 2013 by Ministry of Education, Government of India as an Institute of National importance by an Act of Parliament. The institute is located in Sri City ([www.sricity.in](http://www.sricity.in)) located about 60 KMs from Chennai on the Nellore Highway. The nearest airports are Chennai (70 KMs) and Tirupati (70 KMs). IIITS was setup by the Government of India along with Government of Andhra Pradesh and Industry Partners represented by Sri City Foundation as a Public-Private-Partnership (PPP) institution. The Institute strictly runs as Public- Private-Partnership (PPP) mode and is governed by the Board of Governors consisting of eminent personalities as members from the Government, Industry and Academia. IIITS offers B. Tech, M.Tech, M.S. and Ph.D. programmes in the areas of Computer Science & Engineering, AI and data Science and Electronics & Communications Engineering.

#### I. Posts:

There are **46** vacancies available across the group/departments of CSE, ECE, Mathematics & Data Science and English for Professor (Pay level-14 of 7<sup>th</sup> CPC), Associate Professor (Pay Level -13 of 7<sup>th</sup> CPC) and Asst Professor Grade I, II, III (Pay Level 12, 11, 10 of 7<sup>th</sup> CPC) for CSE and ECE under this 4-tier flexible faculty structure and Associate Professor (Pay Level -13 of 7<sup>th</sup> CPC) and Asst Professor Grade I, II, III (Pay Level 12, 11, 10 of 7<sup>th</sup> CPC) for Mathematics & Data Science. Only Asst Professor Grade III (Pay Level 10 of 7<sup>th</sup> CPC) is available for English. **The number of posts for each cadre may increase or decrease due to administrative reasons.**

### Other Requirements:

- The research areas listed in the advertisement are in general. However, only those candidates will be considered whose areas of research are required for the department/Institute at the time of the selection process.
  - Internal candidates who are fulfilling essential qualifications, relevant experience and other essential requirements, may also apply for these posts irrespective of specializations indicated in the above table.
  - The candidate should be able to teach maximum number of core and/or elective courses at UG and PG Level offered by the department to which the candidate has applied.
  - All the candidates shall have Ph.D. in the relevant discipline and shall have first class in the preceding degrees. The preceding degrees means graduation (UG) onwards.
- (i) In case, the University/Institution does not mention first class in the degrees, the candidates should have passed and secured at least 6.5 CGPA/CPI (on a 10-point scale) or 60% marks in aggregate. Conversion

from CGPA/CPI to percentage or vice versa given by the individual Institute/ University will be considered/allowed for determination of eligibility.

- (ii) In case, the candidate has passed and secured CGPA/CPI under any other point scale (other than 10-point scale), then certificate issued by the authorized signatory (NOT the Mentor/Supervisor/Head of the Department) of the Institute/University to the effect of having secured the first class in such degree must be attached. Alternately, the CGPA/CPI may be equivalently converted on 10-point scale for determination of eligibility.
  - (iii) The above-mentioned CGPA/CPI/Percentage/Degree should be awarded by a recognized University/Institute.
  - (iv) The Institute reserves the right to set minimum percentage of marks higher than first class to shortlist the candidates for presentation/ interview.
  - (v) The candidate should possess at least one degree from graduation onward from IISc/IITs/IIITs/NITs/IIMs/ISI/IISERs/TIFR/IMSc/CMI (for CSE, ECE, Mathematics& data Science). Post-doc from IMSc/CMI will also be considered for short listing, in case of Mathematics& data Science **OR** should be working in a regular pay scale at IISc/IITs/IIITs/NITs/IIMs/ISI/IISERs/TIFR. However, the candidates, who have acquired essential qualification (i.e., Ph.D.) and/or preceding degrees from abroad, shall be considered if degree is offered by National University/Institute of respective country or offered by Institutions that are in QS/THE World Ranking up to 500 (last two years).
5. The period of experience rendered by a candidate on part-time basis, daily wages, visiting/Guest faculty/Purely on Contract Basis (Fixed Remuneration) will not be counted while calculating the valid experience for short-listing the candidates. Last month's pay slip is essential and to be attached.

## II. Instructions for Applicants

- Enclosures, if any, in support of application are to be uploaded as separate documents (pdf) along with the application form.
- A detailed Academic Profile, inter alia, including the following information is required to be submitted:
  - a) A Teaching Plan, indicating core courses that the applicant can teach and also an expanded statement of his objectives and long-term interests in coursework development. In case of candidates having prior teaching experience, the statement should contain student feedback ratings, profiles of 3 best courses taught in the last three years (profile should contain course outline / teaching plan, novel methods used, if any, including online content, term papers, group activity etc.). The statement should also include details of any teaching related awards and details of participation in teacher development programs as participant or as mentor.
  - b) A Research Plan highlighting current and past research interests and achievements and also the future plans for short and long terms. The plan shall also highlight the achievements of guided research scholars especially where one can take pride in the work done or the role played in guiding. In addition, candidates are expected to submit one-page abstract of two research proposals after joining the Institute.
  - c) Details of Journal publications: (SCI /SCIE only)  
Candidates are expected to upload a list of journal publications along with copies of 4 best papers authored by them in the last 5 years chronologically listing:  
Names of authors, Title of the paper, Name of the Journal/Conference, Volume/ Proceedings, pages (from – to), Year, etc. The same shall be grouped as Journal Publications and papers presented at National / International Conferences along with citation count and Journal Impact factors as available.
  - d) Details of Awards, Patents, Prizes etc., indicating:  
Nature, Name of prize/award, awarded by, awarded for, year of award; Name of the patent, year and details about the patent etc. as well as the candidate's specific contribution vis a vis the Co-inventors.
  - e) Research Guidance (only Ph.D. with formal Guide Status):  
Research degree, Name of the scholar, Title of the Thesis, Year of award etc. (on -going supervision) may also be indicated separately.
  - f) Details of Externally funded / Sponsored projects:  
Title of the project, Duration, Sponsor, Value, Co-investigators, if any, role of the candidate and specific contributions etc. Candidates should highlight specific contributions, if any, to industry, pointing out the challenges overcome and the value added etc.

- g) Industrial Experience and Consultancy: Details of industrial experience and relevance to proposed teaching and research.
- h) Other Activities Like:  
Lab Experiments added, outreach activity, E learning/ICT based methodology adopted for teaching, Text books and Monographs if any authorized by the candidate along with details, continuing education programs / conferences organized (as an organizer or co-organizer) etc.
- i) Any other relevant but brief information on academic standing.

**On the above, the Teaching and Research Plan are not required to be submitted at the time of application. Upon publication of shortlisted candidates, the candidates are required to submit the same within the stipulated time. Further, only in case of shortlisted candidates, references will be invited directly from the referees by the Institute.**

#### **1. Age limit:**

- However, for exceptional candidates age may be relaxed at the discretion of the scrutiny committee with the approval of Director. The age is relaxable by 5 years for SC/ST/ PWD and women candidates.
- 2. Only Indian Nationals, Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) and overseas citizens of India (OCI) are eligible to apply. The persons holding the foreign passport are required to provide the details in the application form. Offer of appointment for the individuals with foreign passports will be issued only after the Political and security clearance from Ministries of External Affairs and Home Affairs is obtained.
  - 3. The reservation norms for **PWD, OBC-NCL, SC, ST and EWS** are applicable as per the Govt. of India norms. The candidates mentioning the reserved category in the application should **upload the valid category certificate at the time of applying online** and **failure to submit /upload the category certificate will lead to rejection of their application.**
  - 4. **The candidate should apply only once for a particular post and if they apply second time for the same post, only the application submitted for the first time shall be considered to prevent anomalies in the recruitment process. Hence the candidates are advised to verify and upload all the document/credential/ certificate etc. before applying.** However, candidates applying for more than one post (different post) are required to submit an application for each post separately and pay the fee accordingly.
  - 5. **Candidates employed in Government and Semi-Government Organizations, Public Undertakings, University and Educational Institutes should submit the NOC at the time of interview, failing which they shall not be allowed to appear for the presentation/interview (as per format Annexure 'A')**

6. The Institute reserves the right to offer a lower post including entry level post of the cadre to any candidate taking into account his credential even in case of application for higher post.
7. The Institute reserves the right to screen and call only such candidates as are found suitable and meeting the norms and requirement of research area specified for the department. Thus, just fulfilling the minimum prescribed conditions would not entitle one to be called for presentation/interview.
8. The Institute reserves the right to restrict the number of candidates for presentation/interview to a reasonable limit on the basis of qualifications and experience higher than the minimum prescribed in the advertisement and other academic achievements. In the event of more applicants, the Director can empower the scrutiny committee of Shortlisting, the applications, to further raise the Bar, to restrict the number of applicants to be called for written examination/ seminar interview etc.
9. The decision of the respective committee(s) during the screening and document verification stage, written examination, seminar presentation shall be final, in this regard.
10. Since, Groups/Subjects/Specializations are many and not comparable with each other, following a uniform standard/norm for shortlisting of a candidate by a department is not feasible. Hence, the groups may fix different (and higher) short-listing criteria for a post/specialization.
11. The scrutiny of applications will be done *prima-facie* on the basis of document and information furnished by the candidate in the application. Any discrepancy found between the information given in application and verified by the supporting document at any stage of recruitment/appointment shall render the candidate ineligible. Hence, the candidate is responsible for the correctness of the information provided in the application. Any information given in the application which is incorrect / false / suppressed fact will render the candidature ineligible at any stage during recruitment process or after joining the post if selected.
12. In case of any inadvertent mistake in the process of Screening/ Selection, which may be detected at any stage even after the issue of Offer of Appointment, which renders the candidature ineligible, the Institute reserves the right to withdraw/cancel the offer of appointment.
13. Candidates who have obtained or are expected to obtain their most recent degree (Ph.D.) from IIT Sri City normally not be considered for recruitment, except where there is a 3 years gap between leaving the Institute and the last date of application.
14. All recruitment and pay-fixation shall be done by the Board of Governors (BoG) of the Institute only on the recommendations of duly constituted Selection Committees. Higher initial basic pay may be recommended to exceptionally qualified and deserving candidate(s) with relevant experience by the selection committee. The Selection Committee shall be the only entity empowered to consider the past services and qualifications of an applicant. Top Up pay is recommended for candidates with exceptional qualifications.
15. The invitation to candidate for presentation/interview merely indicates the suitability for the post and conveys no assurance whatsoever that he/she will be recommended or selected or his/her conditions specified in the application will be accepted.
16. The candidates called for the recruitment process will have to appear for the same at their own cost. (i.e. no TA/DA will be paid to the candidates)
17. Any Addendum/ Corrigendum/ Clarification will be published only on the Institute website. Any update on shortlisted candidates, recruitment schedule etc. will be notified on the Institute website only. Hence, the candidates are requested to keep a copy of their application with them for their reference and advised to periodically visit the Institute website for any information/ updates. **The date and time of Presentation/ Interview will be informed only through the Institute website / e-mail. The Institute will not be responsible for non-receipt of emails by the candidates.**
18. Canvassing in any form will make the candidature invalid.
19. The date for determining eligibility of applicants in every respect i.e., qualifications, experience and preferred age limit etc. shall be considered as on the closing date, i.e., the Last Date of the Submission of Application Form.
20. Applicants should not have been convicted by any court of law.
21. No person, (i) who had entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or (ii) who is having a spouse alive, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post. Plural marriage is not permitted.
22. **Candidates applying from and continue to reside abroad can be permitted to attend the presentation/ interview on their request through video conferencing depending on the merit. It is mandatory to have personal presence in the recruitment process for the applicants who are residing in India.**

23. Candidates shortlisted for presentation/interview will have to produce all original documents for verification in support of their application regarding reservation category, educational qualification, experience, NOC (if any), passport (if applicable) and Aadhar card.
24. The selected candidates will be on a probation for a period of two years and no NOC will be given during probation. Candidates may be posted and/or transferred to another department at any time during service career, in the interest of the Institute.
- 25. Selected candidates will be on probation for a period of two(02) years and NoC will not be given during the period. However, if Faculty resigns during probation have to serve till the end of semester and also pay two months of pay for early exit.**
26. The candidates claiming the benefits of reservation are required to upload the valid/relevant caste/category certificates in prescribed format at the time of applying and also to bring the original at the time of presentation/interview. No other certificate will be accepted as sufficient proof.
  - a) OBC-NCL certificate issued on or after 1st April, 2025 shall only be considered for Reservation under OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) category and same to be uploaded at the time of applying. [as per format **Annexure B**]. Wherever OBC is named should be considered as OBC-NCL only.
  - b) EWS certificate issued on or after 1st April, 2025 shall be considered for reservation under EWS category, whose family has gross annual income below Rs. 8.00 lakh (Rupees Eight Lakh only) for the financial year prior to the year of application. Also persons whose family owns or possesses any of the assets as mentioned in DOPT, Govt. of India OM No.36039/1/2019-Estt (Res) dated 31st January, 2019 shall also be excluded from being identified as EWS, irrespective of the family income. The EWS certificate must be uploaded in the prescribed proforma at the time of applying [as per format **Annexure C**].
  - c) The persons with disability (PwD) shall be required to upload the Disability/Medical Certificate in the prescribed form issued by the competent medical authorities for the purpose of employment as per Government of India norms at the time of applying. Persons suffering from not less than 40% of the disability in 2.2 a,b,d and e category shall only be eligible for the benefit of reservation under this category as per DOPT OM No.36035/02/2017-Estt (Res) dated 15 January 2018. [as per format **Annexure D**]
  - d) SC/ST certificates issued by the competent authority should be uploaded by the candidate at the time of applying and also to produce at the time of presentation/interview. [as per format **Annexure E**]
  - e) Latest monthly pay slip from the current employer.
27. No correspondence whatsoever will be entertained from the candidates regarding the reason for not being shortlisted for the recruitment process.
28. The Institute reserves the right to fill or not to fill any or all the posts advertised.
29. Any dispute with regard to the selection / recruitment process will be subject to Courts / Tribunals having jurisdiction over courts of Tirupati dist.

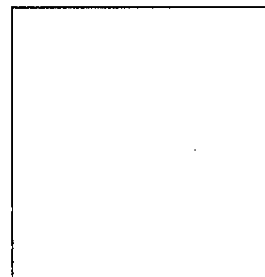
